

SFD Signs First Development Loan Agreement with Suriname to Finance Power Transmission and Distribution Project Worth USD 20 Million

His Excellency Mr. Sultan Al-Marshad, CEO of SFD, signed Fund's first concessional development loan agreement with His Excellency Mr.Keirmech and Raghoebarsing, Minister of Finance and Planning of the Republic of Suriname. The agreement secures USD 20 million in funding to support expansion of Suriname's power transmission and distribution systems

The agreement aims to extend the electrical grid in the capital Paramaribo and the city of Nickerie, enhancing electricity availability for beneficiaries, improving the overall efficiency of the national power network in Suriname , and providing reliable electricity to farms and factories across various regions. Transmission lines are expected to stretch up to .50 kilometers









SFD and UNDP Sign MoU to Support Water Security in Somalia

On the sidelines of the 4th Riyadh International Humanitarian Forum, H.E. Mr. Sultan Al-Marshad, CEO of SFD, signed a Memorandum of Understanding with H.E. Mr. Haoliang Xu, UN Assistant Secretary-General and Director at the UNDP, to implement the grant allocated to the Federal Republic of Somalia under Phase V of the Saudi Program for Digging Wells and Rural Development in Africa. The signing ceremony was attended by H.E. Mr. Aweys Haji Yousuf, Ambassador of Somalia to the Kingdom.

The program aims to improve access to clean water in rural areas of Somalia through development of solar-powered wells and water supply systems. The project will support clean drinking water, help combat desertification, enhance water and food security, and support the agricultural sector, while also reducing the spread of waterborne diseases.











SFD Concludes Participation in Saudi Media Forum as Development Partner

SFD concluded its participation in the Saudi Media Forum 2025 as a development partner. During the event, the SFD received a commemorative shield from the Saudi Broadcasting Authority in recognition of its active communication efforts and meaningful contribution to development-oriented media and public engagement. SFD Wraps Up Participation in the 4th Riyadh International Humanitarian Forum

SFD concluded its participation in the 4th Riyadh International Humanitarian Forum, organized by King Salman Humanitarian Aid and Relief Center, under the patronage of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques, .King Salman bin Abdulaziz Al Saud, held on February 24–25, 2025 H.E. Mr. Sultan Al-Marshad, CEO of SFD, delivered opening remarks during a panel session titled "The Humanitarian-Development-Peace Nexus" as part of the forum's proceedings. In his speech, he emphasized the importance of unifying joint efforts to achieve development across various developing countries worldwide, moving toward sustainable solutions to address future challenges

SFD Signs Two Development Agreements to Support Water and Oil Derivatives Sectors in Pakistan

In line with directives of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques—may God preserve him—and in the presence of H.E. Mr. Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif, Prime Minister of Pakistan, H.E. Mr. Sultan Al-Marshad, Chief Executive Officer of SFD, signed a development agreement with H.E. Dr. Kazim Niaz, Secretary of the Ministry of Economic Affairs of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan. The agreement involves financing of oil derivatives valued at USD 1.2 billion. This new agreement builds upon Saudi Arabia's continued support—channeled through SFD—since 2019 to finance Pakistan's oil derivatives, with total contributions reaching approximately USD 6.7 billion. The support aims to stimulate economic growth, address financial challenges, and enhance key sectors within the country. The signing ceremony was also attended by H.E. Mr. Nawaf Al-Malki, Ambassador of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques to Pakistan, along with senior officials from both sides.

In addition, the two parties concluded a concessional loan agreement worth USD 41 million, provided by SFD, to fund a drinking water supply project in the city of Mansehra, Pakistan.









SFD Strengthens Its Presence at the Global Water & Energy Summit in Spain and Wins Contribution Award

SFD, a global partner in sustainable economic development, participated in the Global Water & Energy Summit, held from February 10—12, 2025, in Valencia, Spain, with an informative exhibition booth.
