# SFD Enhances its Development Activity in Kosovo by Supporting the Transportation Sector

CEO of SFD, Mr. Sultan Al-Marshad, and Minister of Finance, Labor and Transfers of Kosovo, H.E. Hekuran Murati, signed an additional concessional development loan agreement provided by SFD at \$14.13 million in the Republic of Kosovo. The agreement aims to finance the Pristina-Mitrovica Highway Project. The Minister of Environment, Spatial Planning, and Infrastructure, H.E. Liburn Aliu, and the Non-Resident Ambassador of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques to Kosovo, H.E. Faisal Hafzi attended the signing event.

This agreement extends a project initiated in 2013, contributing to development and rehabilitation of the highway. By upgrading basic drainage

services, expanding road lanes to reach 27 km, improving safety standards, reducing accidents, and facilitating traffic flow. Approximately 27,000 vehicles benefit from the road daily and the project will support social and economic growth between regions, creating direct and indirect job opportunities. This agreement marks an important step toward achieving Sustainable Development Goal 11 for sustainable cities and communities.











#### Signing a memorandum of understanding (MoU) to Support Uganda as part of the Saudi Program for Digging Wells and Rural **Development in Africa**

CEO of SFD, Mr. Sultan Al-Marshad signed a MoU with H.E. Matia Kasaija, Minister of Finance, Planning, and Economic Development of Uganda. The grant, valued at \$4 million, is part of "Phase Five" of the Saudi Program for Digging Wells and Rural Development in Africa. The ceremony was attended by the First Lady, Janet Museveni, and H.E. Mohammed Falodah, Ambassador of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques to Uganda.

The memorandum aims to support access to water in rural areas of the Republic of Uganda through building solar-powered water supply networks. The project includes 23 supply systems in 23 rural areas, benefiting approximately 15,000 people, which will contribute to enhancing water and food security.
