# SFD Takes First Step in El Salvador to Support Water Treatment and Energy Generation

H.E. Mr. Sultan bin Abdulrahman Al-Marshad, CEO of SFD, signed the first development loan agreement with El Salvador Minister of Finance, Mr. Jerson Posada. The agreement, amounting to \$83 million, will fund a water treatment and biogas power generation project using water from the Acelhuate River in El Salvador. The signing ceremony was attended by El Salvador Minister of Foreign Affairs, Ms. Alexandra Hill Tinoco, along with other officials.

The project will treat wastewater that currently flows into the Acelhuate River, while also producing biogas for renewable electricity generation. Expected to benefit over 1.2 million people, it will significantly increase El Salvador's renewable energy capacity, contribute to environmental sustainability, and advance progress towards several Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), including clean water and sanitation, and affordable and clean energy.









#### SFD Signs First Development Loan Agreement with Nicaragua to Support Healthcare with \$103 Million

H.E. Mr. Sultan bin Abdulrahman Al-Marshad, CEO of SFD, signed the first development loan agreement with Nicaragua's Vice Minister of Finance and Public Credit, H.E. Bruno Gallardo Palaviccine. The \$103 million agreement will fund the construction and equipping of the Carlos Centeno Departmental Hospital in Las Minas. The signing ceremony was attended by H.E. Iván Acosta, Nicaragua's Minister of Finance and Public Credit; Dr. Martha Reyes, Minister of Health; Mr. Sultan Al-Muzaini, Deputy Ambassador of Saudi Arabia to Mexico; and other senior officials.

The project will construct a 25,000 square meter hospital with a capacity of 300 beds, serving the surrounding regions. The hospital will feature specialized surgical clinics, comprehensive child immunization services, training programs for medical personnel, emergency care departments, and a full suite of integrated healthcare services.

SFD participated in the Hajj Media Forum held in Mecca on the 10th of Dhu al-Hijjah, 1445 AH, as part of an initiative organized by the Ministry of Media. The booth offered an immersive experience through virtual reality technology, allowing visitors to explore some of SFD's major development projects in various developing countries. The VR experience also featured the personal stories of project beneficiaries, showcasing the tangible impact on underserved communities and the role of SFD's financing in advancing the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) globally.










SFD CEO Participates in the OPEC Fund Development Forum and Meets with


### SFD CEO Participates in 19th Meeting of Arab Coordination Group Heads
