The World Bank Group and SFD sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to Enhance International Development Cooperation

Mr. Sultan Al-Marshad, CEO of SFD, signed a MoU with Mr. Ajay Banga, President of World Bank Group, to strengthen international development cooperation and unify joint efforts with International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), International Finance Corporation (IFC), the International Development Association (IDA), and Multilateral Investment Guarantee Agency (MIGA). This agreement was signed during the Annual Meetings of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and World Bank Group in Washington, D.C.

This MoU aims to enable regional and international integration by unifying joint development efforts, exchanging knowledge in developmental activities, and strengthening partnerships through best practices in innovative financing mechanisms. It focuses on sustainable infrastructure and vital sectors to address global developmental challenges. Additionally, this MoU explores effective opportunities for collaboration across various sectors in developing countries and less developed communities worldwide.





MoU between SFD and Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB)

The SFD CEO, Mr. Sultan Al-Marshad, and AllB President, H.E. Jin Liqun, signed a MoU at the 2024 IMF and the World Bank Group Annual Meetings in Washington D.C. The MoU aims to open new avenues for development cooperation and exchange expertise and knowledge between the two parties. This signing event was attended by H.E. Abdulmuhsen bin Saad Al-Khalaf, the Deputy Minister of Finance and Member of Board of Governers of AllB.

This MoU seeks to unify joint efforts in innovative financing mechanisms for sustainable infrastructure and vital sectors. This will be achieved through the exchange of knowledge, efficient practices, technical support, and strategic plans so both parties can address global development challenges. It also focuses on supporting resources through joint initiatives, capacity-building programs, and coordinated communication efforts.

SFD Announces its First Presence in the Republic of Serbia by Financing 3 Development Projects Worth \$205 Million

As a first step in its development initiatives in the Republic of Serbia, the SFD CEO Mr. Sultan Al-Marshad signed three agreements with H.E. Siniša Mali, the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance for the Republic of Serbia. The agreements involve financing 3 development projects through concessional loans worth \$205 million. This partnership aims to fund key projects supporting water, agriculture, education, and energy sectors. The Deputy Ambassador of Saudi Arabia to Bosnia & Herzegovina, H.E. Ali Aldossary, attended the signing event.

The signed agreements aim to enhance irrigation infrastructure and agricultural reclamation in several regions of Serbia. It also aims to establish a Biotechnological Science Campus in Belgrade, and develop the electric transport network. These initiatives are in line with achieving the Sustainable Development Goals by supporting vital sectors that contribute to growth and prosperity in Serbia.





SFD Signed a Memorandum of Cooperation with the Global Water Organization to Support Water Projects Worldwide

SFD Participation in Multilateral Industrial Policy Forum


