The Saudi Fund for Development (SFD) is the main channel responsible for the provision of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia's assistance to developing countries. By doing so, the Kingdom aims to assist those countries implement their development projects and social and economic programs in order to enhance their economy and achieve urban prosperity, thus eventually reaching a balanced and comprehensive development. Accordingly, SFD allocated a considerable share of its commitments to finance a number of social and economic projects and programs. In this regard, the Fund signed, since its inception in 1975 till the end of 2019, a total of 714*loan agreements to finance 680*development

projects and programs at a total amount of SR. 67594.83 million, benefitting 83 development countries across the world.

In view of the growing demand for energy in the developing countries, and the urgent needs to increase its production and expand its networks, and because the industry and mining sector is a main assistance for some developing countries. SFD allocated some of its commitments to finance number of projects in energy and industry and mining sectors. Thus, SFD contributed to finance 88 development projects; of which 42 were in Africa, 45 in Asia and 1 in Other Regions, with a total amount of SR. 12801.26 million.

First- Energy Projects:

Energy is considered one of the main channels of any civilized societies and it supports all economic and social sectors. In addition, energy is of high importance to manage day-to-day life. Given the importance of energy and its development objectives, SFD has assisted in financing a series of projects in some developing countries.

They varied from power plants, transmission lines to networks distribution to beneficiaries. The total amount of these development projects reached 70 with a total amount of SR. 10858.66 million, of which 30 were in Africa with an amount of SR. 4292.54 million, 39 in Asia with an amount of SR. 6455.06 million, and 1 project in Other Regions with an amount of SR. 111.06 million.

Second-Industry and Mining Projects:

SFD contributes in industry projects, as it believes in the importance of this sector in supporting some developing countries as it contributes to the support of other key sectors in those countries. SFD provided loans to finance industrial facilities that directly contribute to agricultural sector such as sugar, cotton and chemical fertilizer plants. In addition, it concluded agreements to support the industrial sector in general. SFD also contributed to the financing of a number of mining projects in some developing countries. These countries depend on the extraction and exportation of its natural resources as an important source of income and support for the economy. 18 development projects in this sector are financed with a total amount of SR. 1942.60 million, of which 12 projects were in Africa with an amount of SR. 1277.22 million, and 6 projects in Asia with an amount of SR. 665.39 million.
