## Introduction:

Due to the importance of the social infrastructure sector in reducing poverty, social infrastructure plays an integral role in improving people's health, enhancing housing conditions, increasing household income, and promoting social progress.

This sector plays an integral role in improving their health and housing conditions. It contributes to increasing their income and social progress. Therefore, SFD has prioritized the social infrastructure sector, encompassing the development of water and sewerage, education, health and housing and urban development sectors. SFD allocated

SR 20966.26 million, which constitutes 29.82% of SFD's total cumulative contributions, to

finance 227 projects and programs, of which 121 were implemented in Africa, amounting to a total cost of SR 12531.94 million. Additionally, 95 projects and programs were implemented in Asia, totaling SR 7472.94 million in financial support. Lastly, 11 projects and programs were executed in other regions, amounting to a total cost of SR 961.38 million.

The following is a brief summary of the SFD's contributions to this sector:

### I. Water and Sewerage:

To increase access to safe drinking water, enhance irrigation and agriculture, and improve the sewerage systems, the Water sector is one of the critical sectors financed by SFD. This sector contributes to the reduction of problems in developing countries, especially the outbreak of diseases and the increase of mortality rate due to lack of potable water or adequate sewerage systems. To date, SFD contributed SR 5181.65 million to finance 50 projects and programs in this sector, of which 29 projects and programs were in Africa amounting to SR 3545.92 million. An additional 16 projects and programs were implemented in Asia, totaling an amount of SR 1196.23 million in financial support. In other regions, furthermore, 5 projects and programs were financed with a total amount of SR 439.50 million.

#### II. Education:

Education is a vital component in growth and sustainable development. In order to enable developing countries and build capacities, SFD allocated the bulk of its contributions in the social infrastructure sector in financing projects and programs in education. SFD contributed SR 6431.43 million to finance 78 projects and programs aiming to develop various activities of this sector, such as the construction of schools, construction of colleges and universities, provision of equipment and materials and

the development of curriculum and teaching methods. SFD allocated SR 3396.72 million to finance 39 projects and programs in Africa, while it allocated SR 3034.71 million to finance 39 projects and programs in Asia. The following table shows the geographical distribution of SFD's contributions to this sector:

#### III. Health:

The health sector is one of the key sectors financed by SFD due to the role it undertakes in developing countries, such as improving the health conditions, eradicating epidemics, and enhancing the quality of life. In this regard, SFD supports the construction and equipping of hospitals, health centers, and the training of medical professionals. To date, SFD financed 66 projects and programs in this sector with a total amount of SR 5471.28

million. 34 of these projects and programs were implemented in Africa, totaling an amount of SR 2891.21 million. An additional 29 projects and programs were financed in Asia, amounting to SR 2338.19 million, while another 3 projects and programs were financed in other regions, for a total support of SR 241.88 million. ### IV. Housing and Urban Development:

Given its impact on physical and psychological well-being, access to adequate housing is critical for everyday healthy living. Additionally, adequate housing represents one of the most important pillars of cultural advancement and social progress. To support developing nations in this regard, SFD financed 33 various projects and programs worldwide with a total of SR 3881.90 million.

In Africa, 19 projects and programs were financed with an amount of SR 2698.09 million. Furthermore, 11 projects and programs and programs in Asia were supported with a total amount of SR 903.81 million, while 3 projects and programs were financed in other regions, for a total amount of SR 280.00 million.
