Introduction:

The Saudi Fund for Development (SFD) is the main entity responsible for the provision of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia's assistance to developing countries, with the aim of helping those countries to implement their development projects and social and economic programs in order to enhance their economy and accomplish urban prosperity, thus eventually reaching a balanced and comprehensive development. Accordingly, SFD allocated a considerable share of its commitments to finance a number of social and economic projects and programs. In this regard, SFD has signed, since its inception in 1975 till the end of 2022, a total of 737* loan agreements to finance 700* development projects and programs,

84 development countries benefited of those projects and programs across the world.

In view of the growing demand for energy in the developing countries and the urgent need to increase its production and expand its networks and because the industry and mining sector is a main contributor in some developing countries, SFD allocated some of its contributions to finance a number of projects and programs of energy, industry and mining sectors. Thus, SFD contributed to finance 93 development projects and programs; of which 44 were in Africa, 48 in Asia and 1 project in other regions, with a total amount of SR 13328.93 million.

^{*} The reason that the number of signed loan agreements exceeds that of programs and projects, is that some projects received more than one loan.





First: Energy Sector Projects:

Energy is considered one of the fundamental pillars of any contemporary societies and it supports all economic and social sectors. In addition, energy is of high importance to manage day-to-day life. Given the importance of energy projects and their development objectives, SFD has assisted in financing a series of projects in some developing countries. They varied from power plants, transmission lines distribution networks serving beneficiaries. The total number of these development projects reached 77 with a total amount of SR 11590.46 million, of which 34 were in Africa with an amount of SR 4665.41 million, 42 in Asia with an amount of SR 6813.99 million, and 1 project in other regions with an amount of SR 111.06 million.

Second: Industry and Mining Projects:

SFD contributes to supporting industry projects, as it believes in the importance of this sector in supporting some developing countries since it contributes to the support of other key sectors in those countries. SFD provided loans to finance industrial facilities that directly contribute to agricultural sector such as sugar, cotton and chemical fertilizer plants. In addition, it concluded agreements to support the industrial sector in general. SFD, moreover, contributed to the financing of a number of mining projects in some

developing countries. These countries depend on the extraction and exportation of their natural resources as an important source of income and support for the economy. 16 development projects in this sector are financed with a total amount of SR 1738.47 million, of which 10 projects were in Africa with an amount of SR 1073.08 million, and 6 projects in Asia with an amount of SR 665.39 million.
