Part of the proceeds of this loan will be used for the procurement of medical and non-medical equipment and furniture under the above-mentioned Project. The bidding is open to eligible participants of International Competitive Bidding (ICB), with a 5% preference margin granted to Joint Ventures (JV) of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia / Kyrgyz Republic.

2. The Ministry of Health of the Kyrgyz Republic (hereinafter referred to as the Purchaser) hereby invites the eligible bidders to the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) with a 5% preference for the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia/Kyrgyz Republic JV to submit their sealed bids for the supply of medical and non-medical equipment and furniture.

3. International Competitive Bidding (ICB) with a 5 per cent preference for the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia/Kyrgyz Republic JV will be conducted in accordance with the Arab Coordination Group (ACG) Guidelines for Procurement of Goods and Contractors.

(a) The minimum average annual turnover of the supplier (calculated as the total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed within the last 3 years, divided by 3) shall be:

(b) The Bidder shall have at least two (2) similar sized contracts successfully executed as a Supplier within the Five (5) last years, with an amount each not less than.

7. Late bids will be rejected. Technical bids will be opened on July 21, 2025 at 14:00 p.m. (Bishkek time) in the presence of bidders.

8. Financial bids will be opened after signing the Evaluation Report on the Technical part, in the presence of invited bidders.

9. The Purchaser shall not be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by the Bidders in connection with the preparation or delivery of bids.
