1. As part of the execution of the Prince Sultan Ben *Abdulaziz Centre for Renal Dialysis rehabilitation project*, financed by the Saudi Fund for Development (SFD), the **Djibouti University Hospital Centre (CHUD)** is launching a call for tenders for the **rehabilitation and extension works, supply of medical equipment and furniture for the Dialysis Centre located at the Peltier General Hospital.**
2. The Government of the Republic of Djibouti, through delegation of project management, has entrusted the **University Hospital Center of Djibouti (CHUD)** with the management of the *rehabilitation project of the Prince Sultan Ben Abdulaziz Center for Renal Dialysis*. The **University Hospital Centre of Djibouti (CHUD)** hereby invites all **eligible and interested bidders** to submit their proposals in sealed envelopes for the following works:
 - **Lot n°01: Rehabilitation and extension work of the Prince Sultan Abdulaziz Renal Dialysis Centre located at the Peltier General Hospital.**
 - **Lot no. 02: Supply and installation of equipment, biomedical furniture, information technology equipment, and office furniture.**

4. The call for tenders is exclusively open to Saudi companies or Saudi-Djiboutian joint ventures, including for the supply of materials/ equipment. Companies and/or groups of companies meeting this requirement are invited to submit their bids at their discretion and may propose unconditional discounts, which will be considered in the evaluation of the bids.

Discounts mentioned in the bid submission letters will be read aloud during the bid opening. Any discount not mentioned in the bid submission letter will not be considered in the bid evaluation.
5. The Tender Dossier (Tender Document) may be purchased by candidates, upon written request to the **University Hospital Centre of Djibouti**, upon payment of a non-refundable amount of Fifty thousand francs (50,000 DJF).
6. All bids must be submitted in one original and two copies to the offices of the **Djibouti University Hospital Center, located at: General Peltier Hospital , Marechal Avenue, no later than 8:00 a.m. on March 21, 2026** , and must be accompanied by a **bid security in the amount of seven million five hundred thousand (7,500,000) DJF, or an equivalent amount in convertible currency for foreign bidders**. Bidders undertake to maintain the validity of their bid for 60 days from the bid submission deadline. Any bid submitted after the deadline will be rejected. Any bid not accompanied by an acceptable bid security will be rejected as non-compliant. The bid security for a consortium of companies must be issued in the name of the consortium submitting the bid, represented by its lead company.
7. The bids will be opened by the National Public Procurement Commission in the presence of representatives of the bidders who wish to be present at the opening session, **on March 21, 2026 at 9:00 a.m.** and read aloud in the meeting room of the People's Palace.

8. Bidders must demonstrate recent experience in projects of a similar nature and scale to the scope of work required for this project. The minimum selection criteria are as follows:
- (a) Having achieved an annual turnover, for construction work, supply of biomedical equipment, acquisition of vehicles of an amount equivalent to **Three hundred million francs of Djibouti (300,000,000 DJF)**.
 - (b) To have successfully completed, as the main contractor, at least one project of the same nature and complexity comparable to that of the Works/Supplies/Acquisitions within the last five (5) years; this experience must be included.
 - **For lot no. 01:**
 - Rehabilitation work on a hospital building.
 - Extension works on a new floor building.
 - **For lot no. 02:**
 - Supply and installation of biomedical equipment for healthcare facilities.
 - Supply and installation of computer equipment and office furniture.
 - (c) Provide proposals for the timely acquisition (ownership, leasing, rental, etc.) of the following essential major equipment and machinery: see Specific Data
 - (d) Propose a project manager with a minimum of ten (10) years of experience in carrying out work/supply/acquisition of comparable nature and complexity.
 - (e) Having liquid assets and/or presenting documents attesting that the bidder has access to, or has at their disposal, credit facilities of an amount at least equivalent to **One Hundred and Fifty Million Djiboutian Francs (150,000,000 DJF)**
9. Only companies and groups of companies that submit bids that comply with the five (5) post-qualification criteria mentioned in the Tender Document will be considered for evaluation.
Any offer that does not meet one or more of these criteria will be rejected.
- The CHUD may declare the call for tenders unsuccessful if the competition is insufficient (less than 03 offers).
10. The contract will be awarded to the company or group of companies that submitted the most advantageous overall offer.
11. There will be a site visit organized later by the CHUD.
12. The **University Hospital Centre of Djibouti** reserves the right not to proceed with all or part of this Invitation to Tender.
